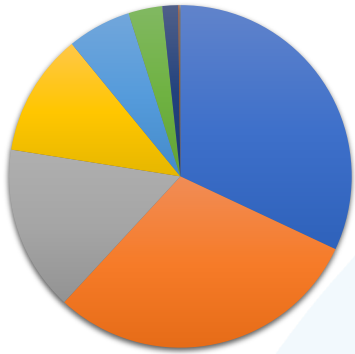

From the Executive Director:

In 2010 a Lincoln cent penny was sold at a private auction for \$1.7 million dollars. One of the rarest pennies, its value was due to a mechanical error with the machines that stamped the pennies. The machines made a very small number of bronze pennies because copper, which was supposed to be replaced because of war rations, was stuck and unnoticed in the stamping machine. This incident in 1943 led to “the most famous error coin in American numismatics.” How a one cent coin can bring a value of \$1.7 million dollars is mind-boggling to me! What unimaginable value was placed on a small coin, basically worthless had this error not occurred.

This Annual Report is our way to communicate our stewardship of resources to you, our supporters, friends, and co-laborers in ministry. As we look at numbers and then associate them with what was a highly unusual year in 2020, I am reminded of our ministry’s focus verse for 2021, Ephesians 3:20-21. “*Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever.*”

My hope is that these numbers reflect how our God can take what we see as a worthless year--one that we all want to just forget--and, despite all the obstacles and fear, continue to do immeasurably more than we could have even imagined. Our God gives this small ministry immeasurable value to those we serve in the past, the present, and for the generations to come. He does this despite our own imperfections, mistakes, or even errors. To Him be the glory!!
